### WE TRIED IT

[something we tried this issue we think you'll love!] Sweetened Condensed Milk Snowballs

- 1 Cup Butter, Softened
- 1/2 Cup Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 Cups All-Purpose Flour

#### Preparation

- 1. Preheat the oven to 320°F.
- 2. Add softened butter to a mixing bowl & beat until light & creamy - about 3 minutes.
- 3. Pour in the sweetened condensed milk & beat into the butter for two minutes. (If adding extracts for flavouring, add it now, but no more than 2 teaspoons)
- 4. Scrape down the sides of the bowl & beat again for another minute or two.
- 5. Finally, add the flour & baking powder. Beat into the butter & milk mixture until mixed through.

- 3 Teaspoons Baking Powder
- 1/2 Cup Confectioner's Sugar \*Makes 22 Cookies
- 6. Using a cookie scoop, portion the dough into mounds onto a parchment paper lined baking sheet, leaving 2 inches in between.
- 7. Bake for 12 minutes.
- 8. Remove from oven & let cool on the pan for 5 minutes.
- 9. Transfer onto a wire cooling rack. Use a sifter to liberally dust the cookies with the confectioner's sugar.
